2012 Ross Family Autism Scholarship

The Ross Family Autism Scholarship was established to honor the two sons of the Ross Family who have Autism. The scholarship is designed to inspire students who are on the Autism Spectrum that they can overcome their disability and pursue their dreams of furthering their education.

Eligibility:

- Graduating senior from a high school in Davis County, Utah or Delaware County, Indiana
 - Applicant must have received a diagnosis of an Autism Spectrum Disorder
 - Applicant must have a grade point average of 3.0 (or the equivalent) or higher
 - For use at any college, university, technical school, vocational school, or community college
 - In selecting a recipient, consideration will be given to academic ability, extra-curricular activities, and community service
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Application Requirements:

The following items are to be submitted by **March 2, 2012**, to The Community Foundation of Muncie and Delaware County, Inc., PO Box 807, Muncie, IN 47308.

- Completed application form
 - Letter of Recommendation
 - High School transcript
 - Evidence of application/acceptance to college, university, technical school, vocational school, or community college
 - Photograph
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Written notification of the Selection Committee's decision will be mailed to applicants by April 30th.

The Scholarship will be sent *directly* to the recipient's college or university of choice.
